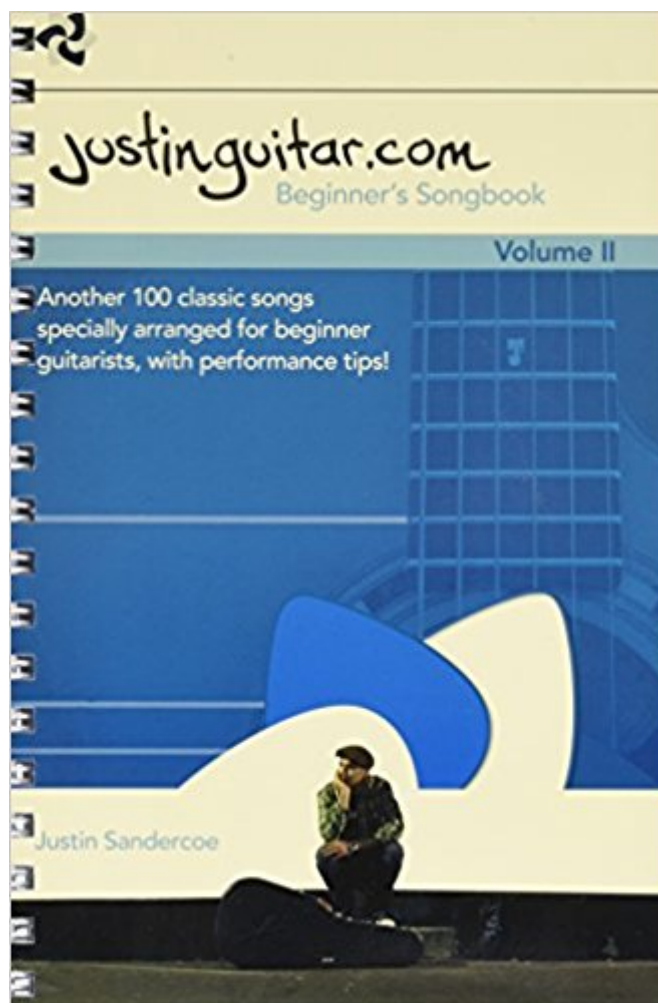

The book is spiral bound and folds nicely, making it easy to read on a table or music stand while you are playing.
