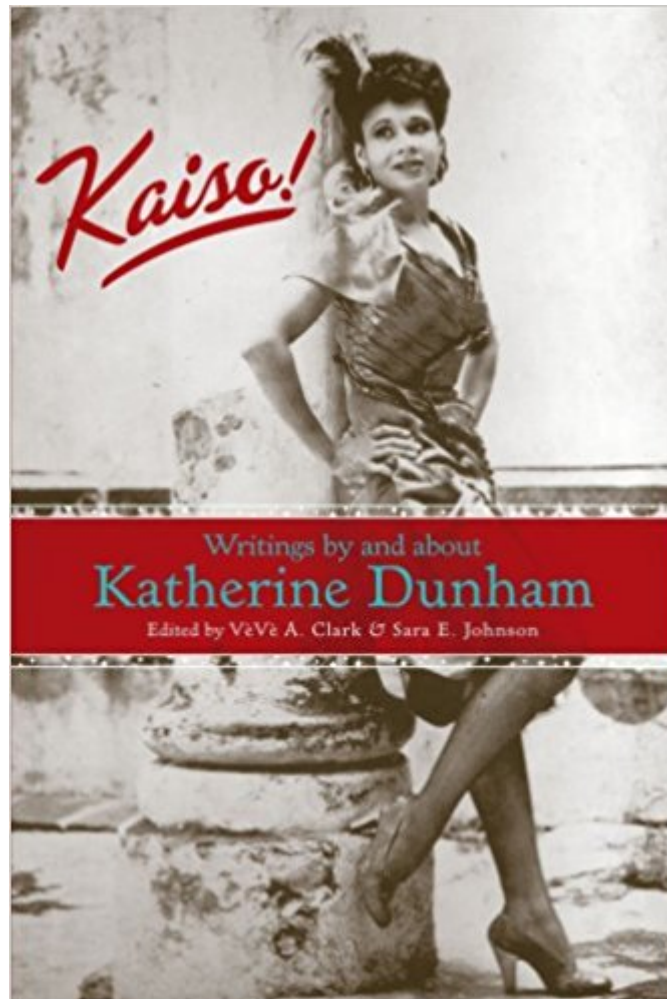


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# Kaiso!: Writings By And About Katherine Dunham (Studies In Dance History)
